



STEERING COMMITTEE RESOLUTION SC03-2012 – APPROACH TO DATA AND INFORMATION

WHEREAS, Section 5.3.3 of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) states that the Steering Committee is responsible for organizing and then maintaining information and resources for the Consortium, including coordinating the Consortium effort to develop and maintain a data repository, website, and network of listening posts, and will ensure full public access to information and data; and

WHEREAS, a subcommittee of the Steering Committee has developed a proposed approach to data and information that was discussed at previous Steering Committee meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Steering Committee, using the subcommittee’s recommendations, adopts the following steps with regard to data and information relevant to the New York-Connecticut Sustainable Communities Planning Program:

1. Each Consortium member agency will identify electronic data bases which are relevant to the various components of the NY-CT Sustainable Communities Planning Program.
2. Consortium members will supply links to selected data bases which will be available on the Consortium website for both public access and for the use of the Consortium members in the execution of the Planning Program.
